Dear Heritage Home owner,

In 1987 the Beaver County Historical Research and Landmarks Foundation formed a committee to find and record information on Beaver County homes and buildings that were at least 100 years old. That has been updated to cover buildings that were built before 1900. Where information is provided, Heritage Markers are available, at a nominal fee, to mark the structure.

This is an ongoing program, expanding and updating those files. If your home was built before 1900, it fits our definition of a Heritage Home and we would like to hear about it. We hope that you will be willing to share information of interest regarding your home, especially if there is historical significance. We ask that you complete the enclosed form to help us in this process.

In addition to information listed on the form, we would greatly appreciate information regarding:

- Previous owners,
- Additions made, or major remodeling.
- Photos (old or new) of the exterior of the house from a few different angles.
- Photos of special or unusual features of the interior.
- Any history, or stories relating to the house and property.

This will provide a record of the building that will be held in the files of The Beaver County Historical Research and Landmarks Foundation here at the Vicary Mansion in Freedom.

If you are interested in having a A HERITAGE MARKER for your home, check “yes” at the bottom of the form and return it to the address at the top of this page. The Marker is a 5” by 7” plaque with a wooden backing and a bronze colored face. The Marker plaque is available for a \$10.00 fee, which could be enclosed with your form. Or the Marker Plaque may be picked up at the Vicary Mansion.

We are open from 10:00 AM till 2:00 PM Monday through Friday, or you could visit us on a Saturday or Sunday during our open house events: Military History Day on the first Saturday and Sunday in May, Vicary Day in mid August, or Applebutter Festival in October. Also, my favorite: Christmas at the VICARY MANSION, the first Saturday in December, when the various rooms are extensively decorated to represent different eras, in the life of the mansion. Come see! . We’d be delighted to see you. Please add \$5.00 if you need to have the marker mailed to you.
